## Neighbourhood Planning Regulations 2012

## Consultation on applications to designate a Neighbourhood Forum and Neighbourhood Area – Finsbury Park and Stroud Green Neighbourhood Forum

Islington Council has received two applications from a community group, the Finsbury Park and Stroud Green Neighbourhood Forum:

1. Seeking designation of the area shown on the plan below as a Neighbourhood Area (to be known as the Finsbury Park and Stroud Green Neighbourhood Area); the Area Application; and

2. Seeking designation as a Neighbourhood Forum for the area shown on the plan below (a more detailed map can be viewed via the weblink below); the Forum Application.

From Monday 14 May to Monday 25 June 2018 the council is consulting residents and those who work or carry on business in the area and other interested stakeholders on both these applications.

Part of the proposed neighbourhood area is in the London Boroughs of Hackney and Haringey and the applications have also been submitted to those councils. If the applications are approved by the three councils then there will be a designated Finsbury Park and Stroud Green Neighbourhood Area and a designated Finsbury Park and Stroud Green Neighbourhood Forum for the area. If such a designation is made no other organisation or body may be designated as a neighbourhood forum for that neighbourhood area until that designation expires or is withdrawn. Once designated the Finsbury Park and Stroud Green Neighbourhood Forum can produce a 'neighbourhood plan', a statutory planning document which contains planning policies for the development and use of land and can be used in making decisions on planning applications in the area.
